Crochet hat patterns:

Easy Beanie

This easy beanie is a great project for beginners. It's made with worsted weight yarn and a simple double crochet stitch.

1. Chain 4 and join with a slip stitch to form a ring.
2. Round 1: Chain 1 (counts as a half double crochet), 11 hdc into the ring. Join with a slip stitch to the first hdc.
3. Round 2: Chain 1, 2 hdc in each stitch around. Join with a slip stitch to the first hdc.

4. Repeat Round 2 until the hat reaches the desired height.
5. Fasten off and weave in loose ends.

Slouchy Beanie

This slouchy beanie is a little more challenging than the easy beanie, but it's still a great pattern for beginners. It's made with bulky weight yarn and a combination of single crochet and half double crochet stitches.

1. Chain 4 and join with a slip stitch to form a ring.
2. Round 1: Chain 1 (counts as a half double crochet), 11 hdc into the ring. Join with a slip stitch to the first hdc.
3. Round 2: Chain 1, 2 hdc in each stitch around. Join with a slip stitch to the first hdc.
4. Round 3: Chain 1, *1 sc, 1 hdc* around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc.
5. Repeat Round 3 until the hat reaches the desired length.
6. Fasten off and weave in loose ends.

Winter Hat

This winter hat is a great way to keep your head warm in the cold weather. It's made with bulky weight yarn and a double crochet stitch.

1. Chain 4 and join with a slip stitch to form a ring.


