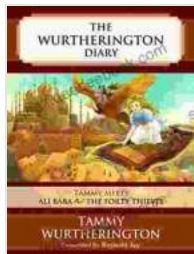


# Tammy Meets Ali Baba and the Forty Thieves: The Wurtherington Diary

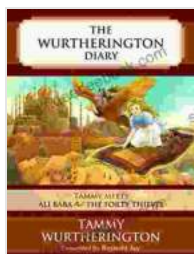

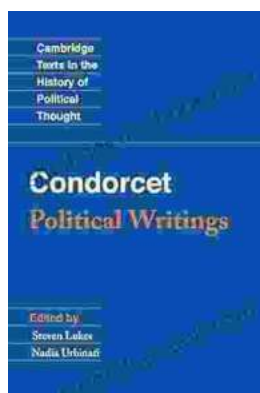
